Job Summary: The Elementary Librarian instructs students in selecting and using research materials and technology; plans, organizes, coordinates, oversees, and provides library services; purchases and catalogs books for library collection; processes and circulates library books, materials, and equipment; processes and shelves library materials; assists students, teachers, and staff in the selection of library materials and equipment; assures that students and teachers have access to library materials for classes, assignments, and recreational reading; provides introduction to the library and the technology within.
